

## Creating a Works Cited Page

To create a new project click the “Create a new project” button once you’re logged in and in “My Projects.”

To work with a project you’ve already created, click the “Bibliography” button under the title of your project.



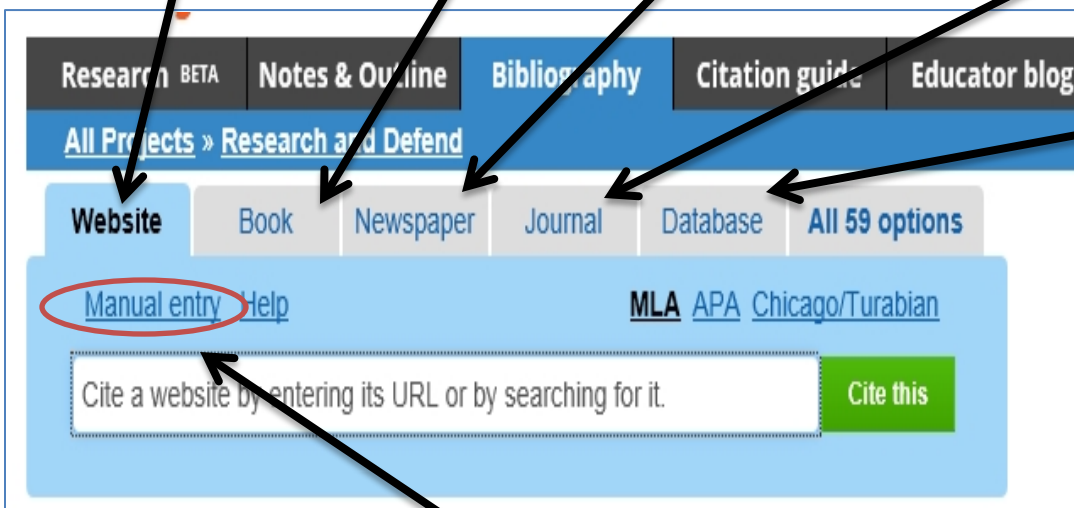
You can create citations for all different kinds of sources. Click on the appropriate source to start a citation.

Websites – any specific site  
You find online

Books

Newspapers – either print or  
or copies you find online  
Be sure to click the right option  
when making your citation.

Journal – this is  
is for journals  
you find in print  
or online, NOT  
in a database.



Database – Anything  
that you find in a  
database – article,  
video, etc. – needs to  
be cited through the  
database link so that  
you are sure to include  
information on the  
database itself, since  
you found the  
information there.

There are some automated functions to EasyBib, but they tend to leave a lot of information out. Citations work best if you click the “Manual entry” link, and enter the necessary information yourself.

When you click the “manual entry” link, you will be brought to a page where you can enter all of the information needed for your citation.

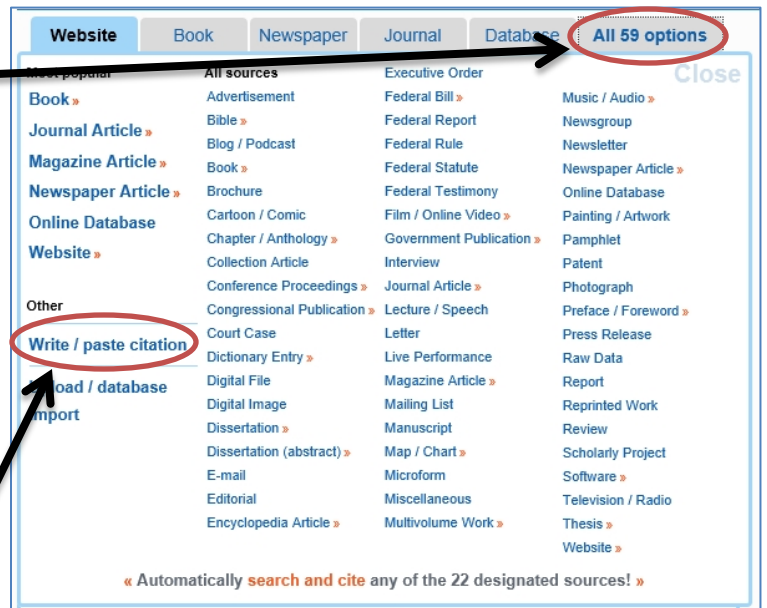
Don't forget drop-down menus!

Look back and forth between EasyBib and your source to find the information you need.

When you're done, click the “Create Citation” button.



If you have a source that isn't included in the toolbar with the five most common types of source, just click the button labeled “All 59 options.” There, you will be able to select a wide variety of different source types, and create your citation.



If you already have a citation ready (some databases or webpages provide you with citations) choose the “Write/paste citation” option under the “All 59 options” menu.

When this box opens, paste your citation in the box, click “Create Citation” and it will be added to your list!
