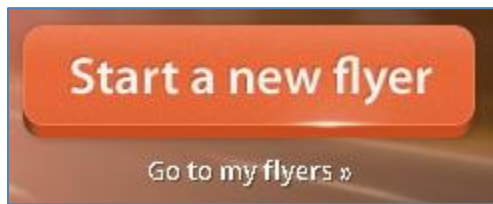

Smore is a site that is designed to create information flyers that can contain media that the ordinary flyer you hang on the wall can't support – things like audio, video, images, maps and more.

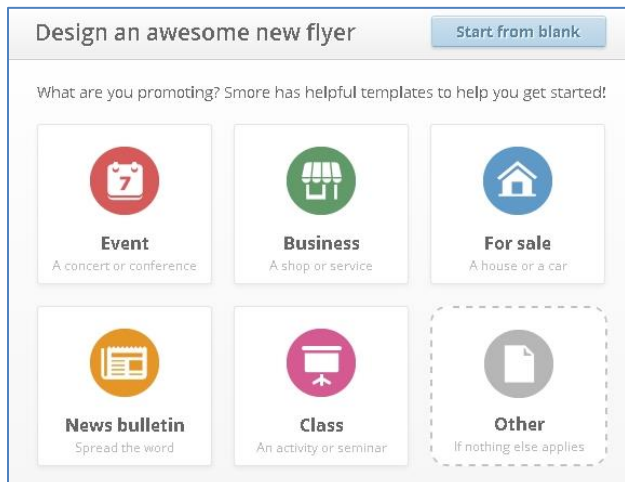

While Smore was designed to help promote events, it's also a very effective presentation tool that is free and easy to use!

Go to <http://www.smore.com> and click the sign-up link. Fill in the information requested to create a smore account.

Click the "Start a new flyer" button to create a presentation.

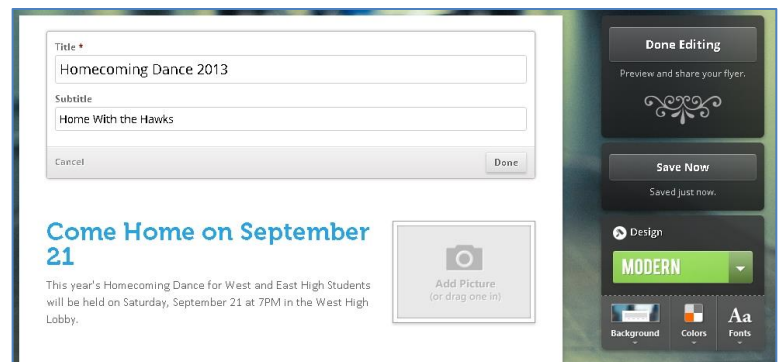


Pick the type of presentation you want to design – it's not a big deal which you choose – there are just different templates in each different type.



Click in each field – text box, title area, image box – to add content. The picture below shows the Title box activated.

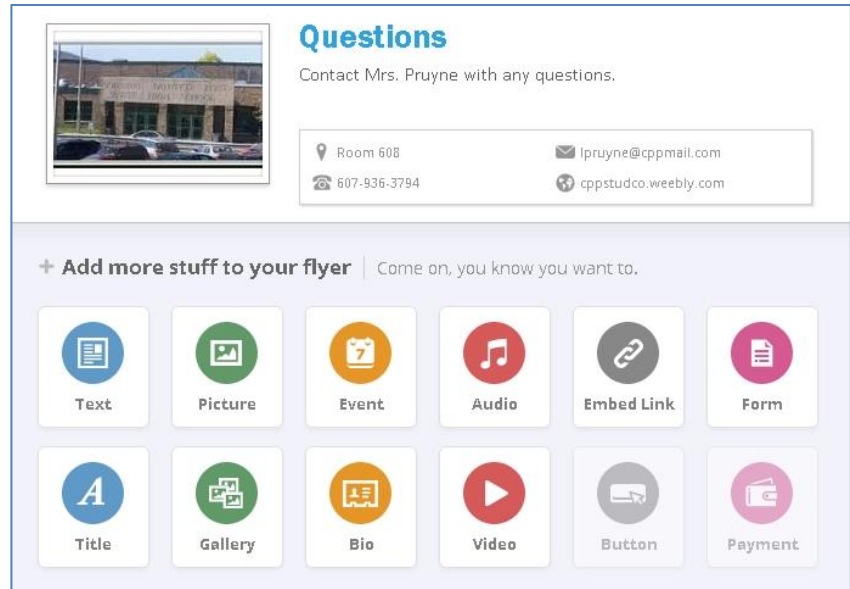
Use the editing menu on the right to change the style, template, fonts and more.





That title menu allows you to change the background image for the smore, the colors, the fonts, etc.

Along the bottom of the smore, you will find buttons for different types of content. Just click on the button. Hold it down and drag it up into the smore to add it to the presentation. Add as much as you need!



When you are done, click the gray button in the share menu that says “Embed.” Copy the code that that generates, and put it in the Google Form on your project page (go to Mr. Shepard’s Weebly – <http://shepardnotredame.weebly.com>) to access your project page.
